It is hosted by the National Institute for Health Research Collaboration for Leadership and Care (CLAHRC) for Northwest London

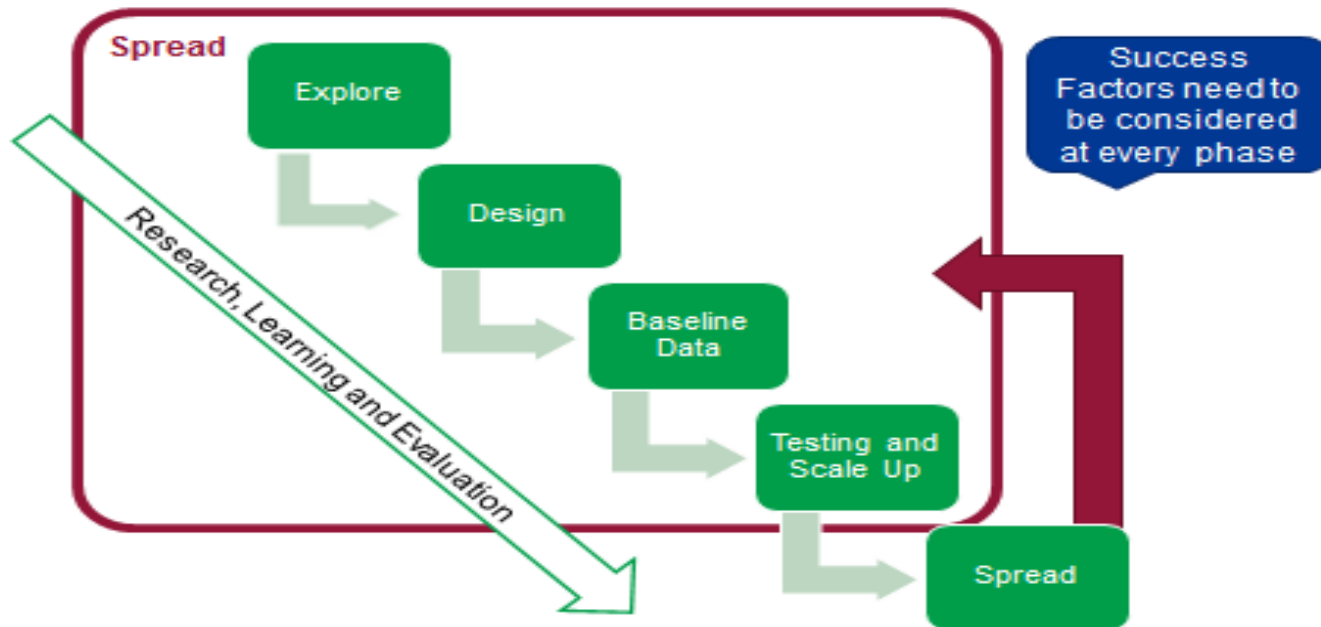
Principles of co-production

- Recognising people as assets

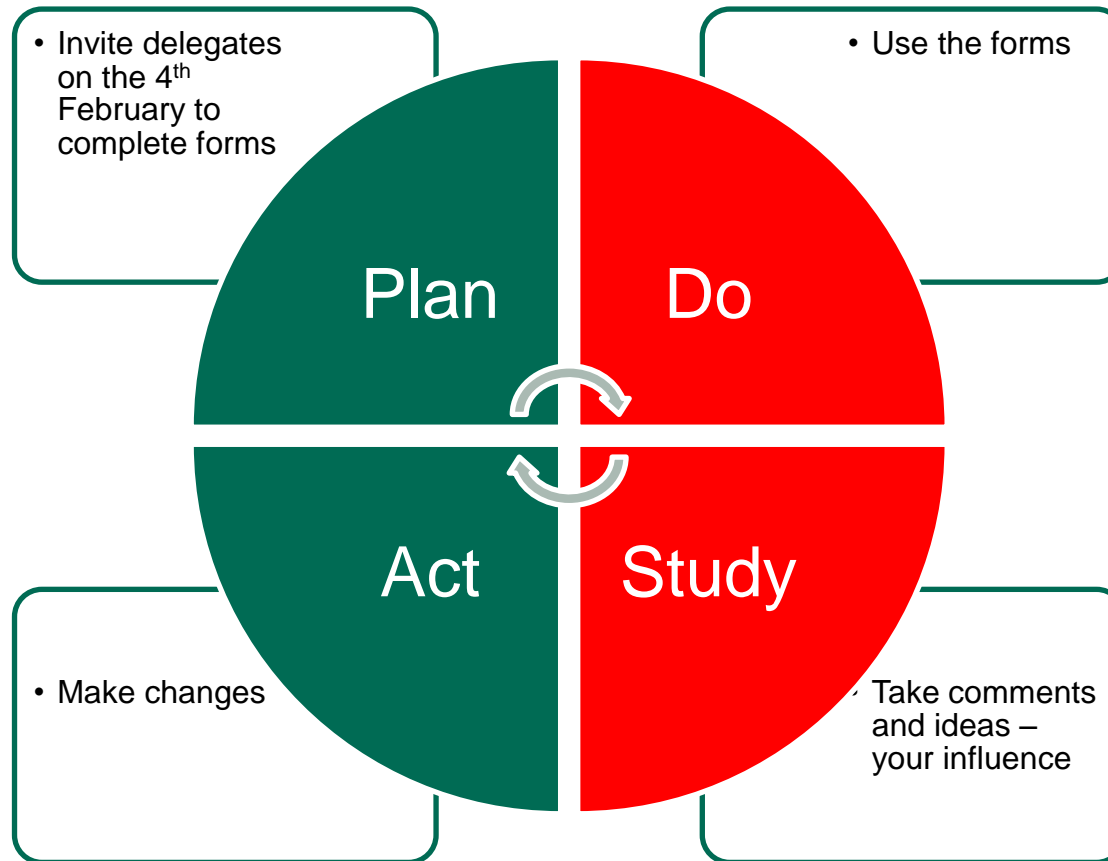
